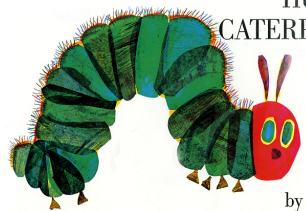


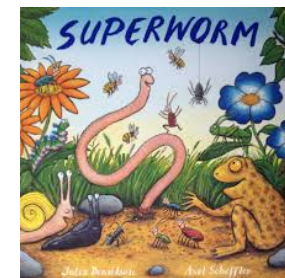
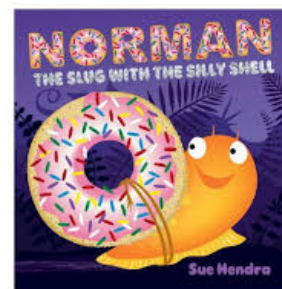

### Parent and Community Links Nursery WOW

Watching caterpillars turn in to butterflies.

Superworm goes on his travels.

Build a wormery

Making a new shell for Norman the snail.

### Physical Development

We will be exploring different ways to move and travel.

We will be developing our writing skills by drawing lines and circles and writing our names.

We will be thinking about how our bodies feel after exercise and how to be more independent when dressing.

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be developing a sense of pride when we complete a task and accepting praise for what we have done.

We will be thinking about our own feelings and the feelings of others.

We will be considering the needs of others and learning to be more tolerant.

### Communication and Language Development

We will be joining in with familiar stories such as The Very Hungry Caterpillar.

We will be asking questions to find out why things happen when looking at life cycles, growth and change. In role play we will be pretending that an object stands for something else and talk about it.

### Reading

We will be looking at story structures and thinking of our own endings to different stories. When reading stories, we will be talking about the settings and describing the characters. We will be looking at familiar logos and labels that we may recognise e.g. shop names, food labels.

### Writing

We will be copying letters from our names, exploring mark making using different techniques and giving meaning to the marks we make. We will be giving meaning to marks we see in different places e.g. signs and labels.

### Understanding the World

We will be thinking about what makes us different to others and things that are the same.

We will be planting flowers and vegetables, talking about the changes we observe and asking questions to find out more. We will learn how to take care of our plants and other living creatures.

We will be taking care of some caterpillars and watching as they change in to butterflies. We will be using Ipads to find out more about growth and change and looking after plants.

### Creative Development

We will be exploring colour and how colours can be changed to make butterfly wings.

We will be exploring different textures through a variety of materials in the workshop.

We will be listening to different types of music and creating movements.

We will be using superheroes and princess figures when making up our own stories.

### Maths

We will be playing different games and beginning to keep scores by representing numbers e.g. football, skittles.

We will be encouraging the children to look at different groups of objects and explore number combinations.

We will be looking at numerals all around us and practising number recognition.
