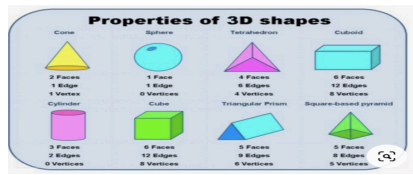

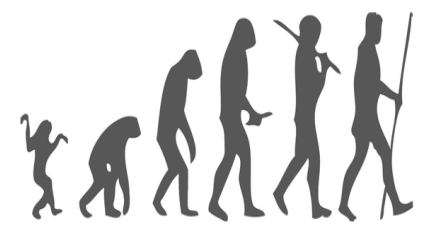
Year 6



In English we will be exploring and writing quest stories, persuasive speeches and explanatory texts.

We will be reading the novel 'Tom's Midnight Garden' by Philippa Pearce.

In Science our unit is 'Evolution and Inheritance'. We will research how living things have changed over time and how fossils provide information about things that lived millions of years ago. We will also learn about how living things produce offspring of the same species how they are similar/different to the parent(s).



In RE we will be focusing on Islam and focusing on the question: 'What is Hajj and why is it important to Muslims?'

In Design Technology we will be investigating and making healthy pizzas as part of our food technology unit. This will include tasting a variety of different toppings to decide what we want on our pizzas.



In Art we will focus on sculpture and will study the works of three different prominent names in this area: Norman Foster, Jeff Koons and Alexander Calder.

In PE our units will be gymnastic and hockey. In gymnastics we will focus on how to accurately take off and land from different positions, including from a range of equipment. In hockey we will focus on how to move with the ball and pass with accuracy.

In PHSE, we will be discussing the different habits we can develop, the risks of illegal substances as well as appreciating the diversity of cultures, religions and beliefs of people living in the UK.

In Maths we will be completing our unit on measure by looking at the area and perimeter of triangles and parallelograms. In geometry, we will be recapping on the properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes, including faces, vertices and edges. We will also be learning how to accurately measure and draw angles using a protractor.

In Music we will be listening to and appreciating traditional music from each of the four countries of the UK as well as Republic of Ireland.

In French our unit is 'The Planets'. We will learn how to say the name of all the planets in French, as well as the sun and moon. We will also learn to say and write larger sections of French relating to the planets.
