In English we are going to be focusing on fiction and non-fiction books linked to our Science topic all about living things and their habitats. We will be writing our own fact books about animals.

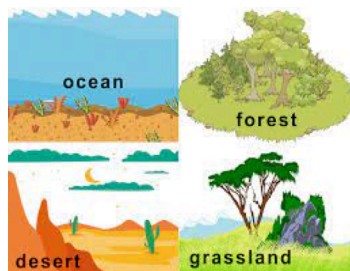
In Maths we will be focusing on developing our knowledge of numbers and place value to 100. We will be learning about practical ways to solve multiplication and division problems. Year 1 will also be learning about position and direction, which will link to our work on algorithms in our computing topic.

In History we are going to be learning about toys in the past and how they have changed. We will be comparing their similarities and differences to those of modern toys.

In Science our focus is going to be learning about living things and their habitats. Children will learn why habitats are important to animals. They will compare how habitats are different and similar. The children will learn how animals have adapted to habitats changing due to environmental developments. Pupils will discuss and identify ways we can protect and preserve habitats.

In PE we are going to focus on continuing to develop our fundamental skills through small-sided games. We will also be focusing on our accuracy through target games.

In Computing we are going to be learning how to write and send emails. We will also be learning how to programme algorithms using our position and direction knowledge from Maths. We will programme Beebots to complete challenges.



In Music we will be listening and appraising a piece of music about imagination. Children will learn the lyrics and actions to the 'Imagination' song. Using this as inspiration the children will compose their own piece of imagination themed music using

In RE we are going to learn about Islam and how they view the story of creation. Children will also discuss and learn how members of the Islamic faith demonstrate their devotion to their faith in everyday life.

In PSHE we will be discussing how we should value and respect everyone's differences. We will also be learning about ways to look after our environment and habitats. We will continue to discuss roles and responsibilities inside and outside of school.
