How you can help at home.

Please read with your child at least 3 times a week. Talk about the stories you read together and their home/school reading books.

Practise on and back to 20 and beyond. This will help your child when they are adding and subtracting numbers using a number.

Ensure your child has access to pencils, felt tips and crayons so they can draw pictures and add labels, captions and sentences to their work.

Ask your child to talk about the changes in the weather and season. Observe the changes around them for example, flowers in bloom now it's Summer time and the weather feeling warmer. Talk to you child about the importance of keeping safe in the sun including wearing sun cream and a sun hat

Please work with your child at home to complete their Boundary Learning Together task on Seesaw each week.
