


## Year 4 Summer 2



In Reading into Writing, we will be reading then writing a story around a theme. Then towards the end of the year, we will be exploring classic poetry.

In GPS, we will focus on accurately using inverted commas in speech and writing

In Geography, we will be learning about the UK's coastline.

Firstly, we will learn about erosion and what four main types of erosion there are along our coastlines. Then, we will find certain locations along our coastline and explore how they have changed over time.

In PE, Laurel will continue going swimming every Wednesday. You MUST remember your full kit each week. Whilst they are swimming, Maple will continue their PSHE and French journey with Miss Stanbridge.

In your second PE slot, you will be focusing on different aspects of Athletics. Let's hope it gets us in the mood for the 2021 Summer Olympics.

Another busy half term in Maths! We have three units of geometry this half term. Our first unit will be about angles, where we will look at different types of angles. Next we will look at shape and symmetry, some of which will be some Year 3 objectives you will have missed last year. Then we will move on to position and direction. In this unit we will talk about how we can describe how a shape moves on a graph.

In RE, we will be learning about Christianity. This half term we will be focusing on Jesus and exploring whether or not sacrifice is an important part of religious life.

In PSHE, we have two different units to learn all about. Firstly, we will learn about how best to express our feelings and emotions. There will be lots of chances to look at different scenarios and discuss them. Then, we will learn about rights and responsibilities we have, not only for now but in the future too.

In French, we will be looking reading and telling a well-known story. We will use lots of visual aids to help us with this.

In Art our unit of work is all about sculpture. We will be researching the works of Michelle Reader and Antony Gormley to begin with.

Then we will investigate how to make our own sculptures, which we will plan, make, improve and evaluate.

Our Science unit for the last half term is all about living things and their habitats. This was your Science topic when we were in lockdown in January, so we are going to have a recap.

We will also catch up on learning about plants because you missed this during lockdown in Year 3.

In Music, we will be using Charanga Music School's Reflect, Rewind and Replay programme. We will listen to a variety of musical genres and use our new musical vocabulary to appraise it.
