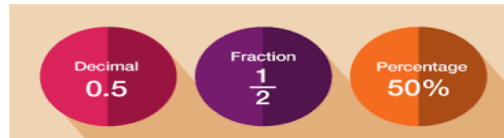


Summer 2

Year 5



In Reading into Writing we will be looking at figurative language in poems, focusing on the Highway Man. We will also be writing a non chronological report based on forces, which is our science topic for this half term. In GPS, we will continue to learn about relative clauses, modal verbs and look at how commas can be used to avoid ambiguity.

Our PE lessons will focus on developing teamwork through the game of cricket and improving our running, throwing and jumping skills in Athletics.

In PHSE, we will focus on rights and responsibilities. We will learn about human rights and the UN declaration of 'Rights of a Child'. We will discuss how antisocial behaviour can affect well-being and understand how to handle, challenge or respond to these types of behaviours.

Our Art and Design lessons this half term will focus on painting. We will look at the work of David Hockney and Claude Monet before creating our own masterpieces.

In Maths we will be learning about decimals and percentages. We will read, write and order decimals up to 3 decimal places and round decimals with 2 decimal places to the nearest whole number. We will then use our new learning to solve problems, before moving on to percentages. We will learn to recognise the % symbol and understand that percent relates to the number of parts per 100. Finally, we will solve problems that require knowing percentage and decimal equivalents to common unit fractions.

This half term in RE, we will be focusing on Judaism. We will learn about the key aspects of the faith and then answer the question: Do people need laws to guide them?

In Computing we will focus on programming. We will learn how to design, write and debug programs and use reasoning to explain how simple algorithms work to detect and correct errors.

Our Science lessons this half term will focus on forces. We will identify and name various forces including gravity, air and water resistance. We will carry out investigations to explore these forces and work scientifically, discussing fair tests and variables.

In French we will focus on the history of the Olympics and a selection of Olympic sports. We will learn how to say 'I play' and 'I do not play' a sport using the verb *faire*. We will also introduce a variety of famous Olympians, examining how we express sports and nationality using the correct grammar.

Our Music focus this half term will be 'Reflect, Rewind and Replay'. We will consolidate our learning throughout Year 5 by listening and appraising various genres of music and using the correct musical terminology.
