Our independently trained staff can help explain Special Educational Needs, Disability or exclusion processes and procedures in straightforward language, so you know what to expect and what part you can play in your/your child's education.

We provide independent, accurate, unbiased advice and information to build your confidence and help you make informed decisions.

- Help develop and encourage good communication and relationships between all parties – parents/carers, children/young people, educational settings, Blackpool Council and other organisations – to achieve the best possible outcomes for children and young people and prepare them for adulthood
- Ensure the views wishes and feelings of parents/carers, children and young people are heard and valued
- Provide impartial, information, advice and support to enable participation in decision making



Can we help you?
