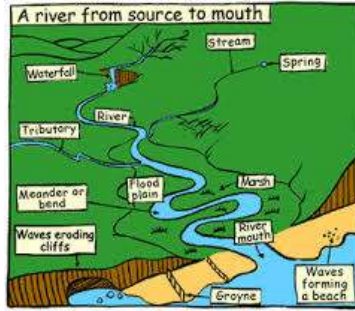


**Summer 2**

**Rocking Rivers**



In English we will be learning how to write in different genres. We will read local and national legends and produce our own, creating poems with different structures and taking part in choral speaking.

In Design Technology, we will design and make a prototype using textiles and think about how we can recycle materials. We will consider key events that have helped shape the world.

In Computing, we will become web designers and use hyperlinks to create and present information in different ways. We will talk about SPAM and pop ups in online safety.

Our PE lessons will focus on developing our hockey skills of passing, dribbling and shooting and we will continue to bowl underarm with accuracy and strike a ball in Rounders.

In PSHE we will consider the values that influence how people spend their money and understand how spending affects the environment in other parts of the world. We will discuss life experiences and understand why it is important to be resilient when dealing with feelings.

In Maths we will continue to learn about angles, shapes and measures, using translation and rotation of different polygons. We will move onto calculating the perimeter and area of different rectilinear shapes and triangles. We will convert between different units of measurement including, kilometers, kilograms, and begin to understand imperial and metric measures. We will keep solving problems with all 4 operations.

In French, we will revise the weather and seasons and prepare a French presentation about UK weather.

In RE we will be exploring Judaism and the meaning of the Jewish rules and laws to find guidance.

In Science, we will learn about the properties of materials and the basis of their properties, including hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivities and the reasons behind this.

In Geography we will learn new vocabulary associated with rivers and how they are formed.

In History we will investigate how Blackpool was affected by World War One, using sources and appropriate vocabulary.

In Art we will study and investigate Cezanne and still life paintings using similar tools and techniques.

Music will focus on listening, singing and appraising popular music and improvisation.
