Sensational Seasons

In Writing this half term we will be receiving and writing letters, writing lists and invitations and exploring non chronological reports.

Who will we receive a letter from? Who will we write a letter back to?

Don't forget your 'Superhero Writing Powers' ... finger spaces, capital letters, full stops and to re read your writing to check it makes sense!

In Mathematics we will be focusing on :

Ordering and recognising numbers to 100.

Counting accurately forwards and backwards to 100.

Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

Identifying one more and one less than a given number.

Adding and subtracting numbers to 20.

Recognising and describing the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

In Science we will be learning autumn and winter. We will learn about the seasons and how and why these change throughout the year.

Music this half term will link with our Science topic, learning about the seasons. Towards the end of term our music focus will change to Christmas carols and songs.

In RE we will be continuing to learn about Christianity and God. We will also learn about the Christmas story and why Christmas is such a special and important time for Christians, but also for a lot of other people too!



In PE we will be participating in games activities this half term with the focus being rolling and kicking balls.

In Design Technology we are going to be cooking! We are also going to make and design our own moving pictures that could go inside a storybook. We will look at sliding and loving picture books first to see how they work and why authors have designed their books in that way.

In PSHE we will be learning how to keep ourselves safe, how to live healthily and lead a healthy lifestyle and we will be doing some work around anti-bullying for national anti-bullying day.

This half term our topic Boundary Learning Together (BLT) will be about the seasons, keeping safe and our class novel 'Room On The Broom'.
