PE

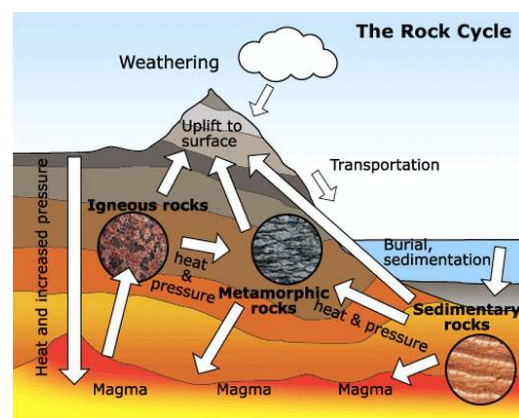
