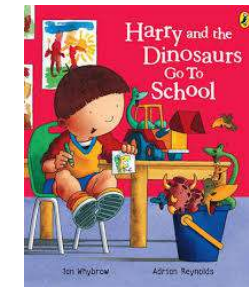
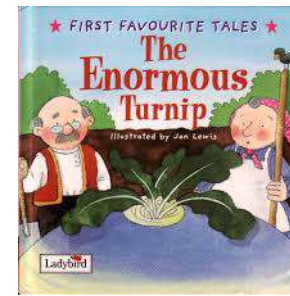
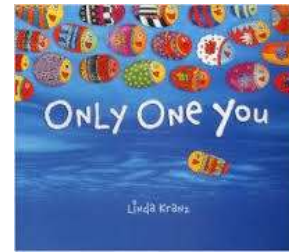


Autumn 1 - One In A Million

Moving and Handling

We will be using lines and circles to paint portraits.

We will be using scissors when making pictures and models.

We will be using one-handed tools to create models with salt dough.

Personal, Social and Emotional

We will be building friendships and talking about things we like.

Communication and Language

We will be following simple instructions.

Reading

We will be learning and joining in with songs and rhymes.

We will be listening to stories and starting to join in with familiar parts.

Writing

There will be lots of opportunities to practice our mark making and we will start to talk about the marks we have made.

We will have opportunities to use numbers in our play.

We will begin to use number names accurately when we are playing.

There will be lots of opportunities to practise counting to 10.

Shape, Space and measure

We will be exploring shape & space by playing with shapes.

We will be practicing using language to describe where things are e.g. on top, behind and next too.

We will be thinking and talking about special times in our lives.
