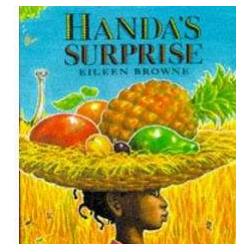
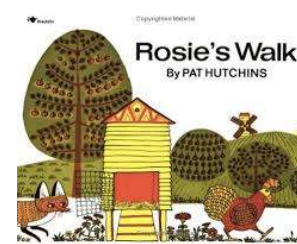

Mathematics

Number

- We will be learning to recognise numbers 1-5, count objects to 10 and begin to count beyond 10.
- We will be using the language of more and fewer to compare two sets of objects.

Shape, Space and Measure

- We will be beginning to use mathematical names for solid 3D shapes and flat 2D shapes and mathematical terms to describe them.

Physical Development

- We will be learning to hold our pencil between our two fingers and thumb and use good control when mark making.
- We will be learning to form some letters correctly including those in our name.
- We will be practising to throw, catch, pat, and kick a ball with increasing control.

Understanding the World

People and communities

- We will be showing an interest in the lives of people we know and talk about special times with our family and friends.
- We will be learning about different occupations and ways of life.
- We will be talking about how our lives are different to other peoples.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- We will be initiating conversations with our friends and listening and responding appropriately.
- We will be adapting to our new school environment, getting along with others in our new class and following our new rules and routines.
- We will be learning and talking about each other's families.

Expressive Art and Design

- We will be making models using recycled materials, leaves, other natural materials and objects.
- We will be listening to new songs and adding movements to them.

- We will be using props to help us act out the stories that we read

Communication and Language:

- We will be learning to concentrate and sit quietly during carpet time and other learning activities. We will be beginning to understand how and why questions.
- We will be using language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations.

Reading

- We will be reading lots of stories looking at and describing main story, setting and characters.
- We will be learning to segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together.

Writing

- We will be learning to hear and say the initial sounds in words.
- We will be drawing pictures and story maps and beginning to label them using knowledge of new sounds learnt.
