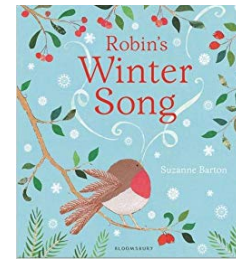
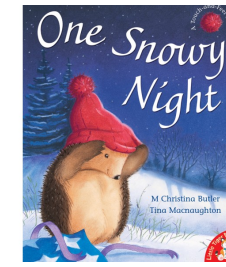
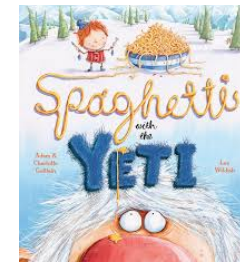


## Spring 1 - Our Wonderful World

### Maths

We will be recognising, counting and ordering numbers to 20

We will be finding one more and one less from a given number to 20

We will be using quantities and objects to add and subtract two single digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer.
