How you can help your child at home:

- Practise spellings on Spelling Shed.

- Top Marks Hit The Button is a great website for practising number bonds and times tables or Times Table Rock Star
- Use Seesaw to show what you have been doing.
- Practise telling the time with your child everyday.
- Recognise numbers, shapes, words in everyday life, reading labels/packages and recipes together.
- Help them get to school every day and on time because attendance is key to great learning!
