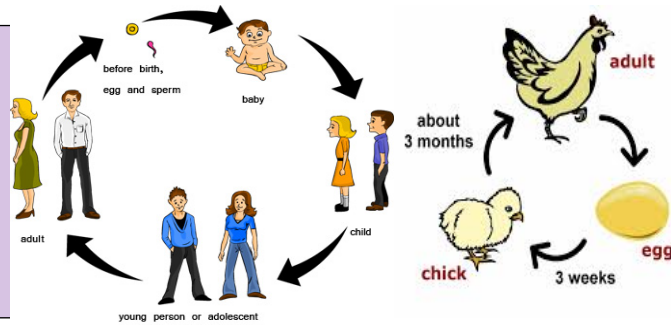

In Geography, we will be focusing on North America and South America. We will be developing our knowledge of latitude, longitude, time zones, climates and vegetation.

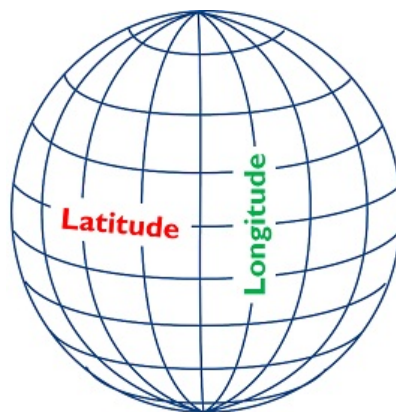
In Computing, we will be learning how to create specific algorithms so that we can create a game in Scratch.

Our PE lessons will focus on developing our running skills in isolation and evaluating our own success. We will also be learning to bowl underarm with accuracy and how to strike a ball in rounders.

In Maths we will be focusing geometry, angles, shape, position and direction. We will be learning to distinguish between regular and irregular polygons based on reasoning about equal sides and angles.

We will identify, describe and represent the position of a shape following a reflection or translation, using the appropriate language, and know that the shape has not changed. We will also be drawing, measuring and identifying angles.



In Science, we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will describe the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird. We will also be describing the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals. All of our learning will be consolidated with a trip to the zoo.

In RE we will be exploring Christianity and meaning of the symbols used.
